




Christmas in Kenya

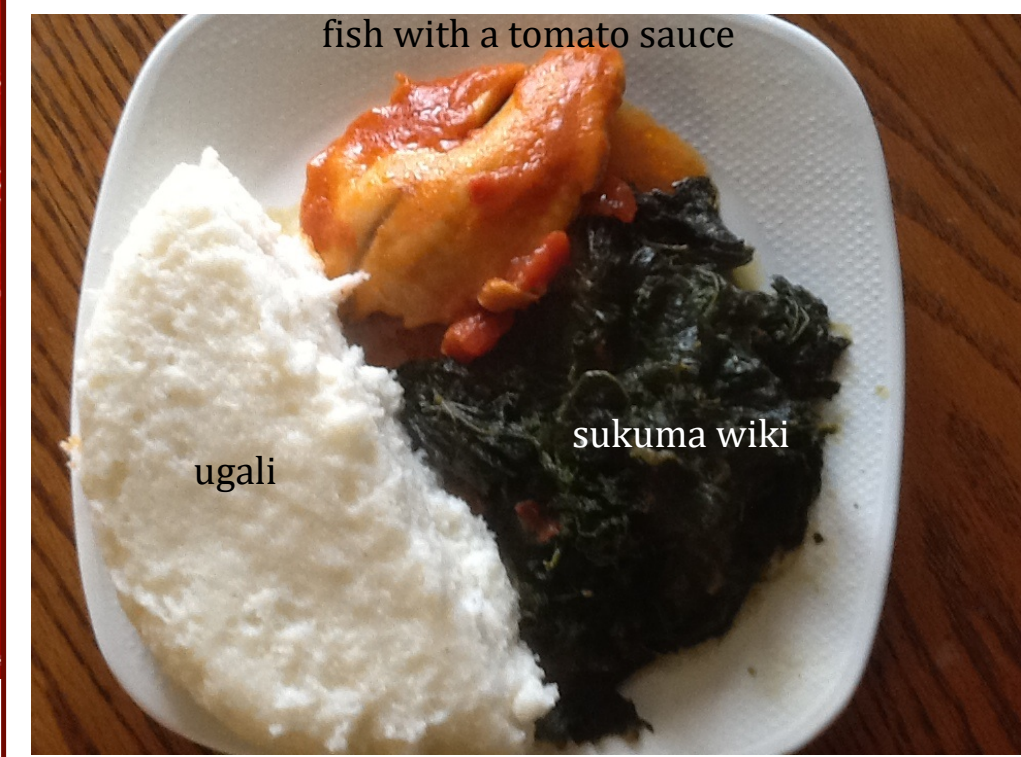


Christmas Recipes

Going to church on Christmas is very important.


